

Nottingham Climbing Centre Health and Safety Policy Statement

The aim of this statement is to ensure that all users of Nottingham Climbing Centre can climb and work in a safe and enjoyable environment at all times.

Nottingham Climbing Centre provides a facility that enables individuals to climb indoors in an environment that minimises risk. The centre aims to provide facilities that are friendly and have numerous challenges for climbers of all ages and abilities. Nottingham Climbing Centre will continually review its health and safety arrangements and ensure it meets its legal requirements. The centre also recognises this is an integral part of its business and will endeavour to always use best practice in its operation.

To meet its aims Nottingham Climbing Centre will;

- Communicate and document the health and safety arrangements and ensure that these are available to staff and clients alike.
- Provide adequate control of the associated risks arising from activities held at the climbing centre.
- Train all staff in assessing client's competency and needs for training.
- Ensure that all staff are trained in first aid.
- Provide and maintain safe equipment.
- Prevent accidents and ensure that all accidents are reported correctly.
- Maintain safe and healthy working conditions. Review and revise this policy with the staff as necessary.
